You will also be aware, as stated in the information sent out on Tuesday, 30 June 2020 that, as the government have relaxed social distancing for children, **ALL** children will attend school from Thursday, 3 September 2020.

Nursery children should follow the start-up information that Mrs McConnell has sent out via Seesaw.

I am very aware that there are a rising number of COVID cases but until we hear otherwise we will follow the plan that we laid out at the end of June.
