Parent/Teacher Consultations

Parent/Teacher Consultations were due to take place the week of Monday 8 February. Due to school being closed and remote learning ongoing, consultations will **BE POSTPONED** and will take place at some point between Half Term February & Easter. The exact dates will be confirmed in due course and will depend on any further decisions by the Executive regarding school closures.

However, as Miss McWhirter will finish teaching in WPS on Friday 12 February, (Mrs Hagan is due to return from maternity leave on Monday 22 February), she will conduct her parent/teacher consultations by telephone on Thursday 11 & Friday 12 February. Further details will be issued closer to the date.

In addition, Y7 consultations will take place on Thursday 25 & Friday 26 February in order to support parents as they begin the Post Primary application process. Again, further details will be issued closer to the time.

Remote Learning

I would encourage all children to engage with the tasks set through Seesaw, however I also understand that every family will manage remote learning in different ways. I know that some parents will complete the work with their children in the evenings, at the weekends or just at any time they can.

Teachers keep a record of the tasks that children complete but not when they completed the task. It may not be possible for you to complete a task on the day that it is sent. We fully understand. There may also be times when you cannot complete the tasks at all. I have spoken to a family this week and both mum and dad have tested positive for COVID-19. If you find that you are having difficulty completing the tasks due to illness or other family issues just be in contact with the teacher. Let them know the situation and agree a date when you will re-engage.

Please be assured that all of the teachers will continue to be very flexible regarding Seesaw. The teachers fully understand, as some of them are also trying to manage home-schooling their own children, while teaching their class remotely.
