## **Dear Parent**

At the moment the BBC weather forecast for Tuesday, 6 June is favourable and we are very hopeful that Sports Day will take place as planned. Obviously, a lot can change between now and then and I will confirm whether Sports Day will proceed or not on Monday, 5 June.

The timings for Sports Day are as set out below:

9.15 – 10.30 Nursery, Y1 & Y2

(All Nursery children will go home following their sports. Y1 & Y2 children can go home with their parents at 10.30 or remain in school until 12.00 when all children in Y1 & Y2 will go home).

10.45 – 12.00 Y3 & Y4

(All Y3 & Y4 children will go home following their sports at 12.00).

1.00 - 2.50 Y5 - Y7

If the weather is good, all children should have sun cream applied before they come to school. They should also bring a sun hat and a bottle of water that they can take out to Sports Day with them. It would be great if children could wear a t-shirt of the appropriate colour for their house on the day. House colours are: Chester – Red, Castle – Blue, Donegall – Green, Temple – Yellow.

The classes remain together during Sports Day and your child will not be able to run backwards and forwards to see you. Please talk to your child beforehand about staying with their class and that they will see you when Sports Day is over.

The Photo Guys, previously SDS Photo, will be present at Sport's Day taking photos of the children which you can then purchase and have printed there and then.

Tea or coffee will be provided by PTA at a cost of £1. It would be helpful to the environment if you could bring you own cup. And finally, don't forget to bring you own seat.
