- Friday Burns Basketball & Coding


Parent/Teacher Consultations

For your information, the online application process (for applying to Post Primary School) will open on Tuesday 30 January @ 12 noon and close on Thursday 22 February at 12 noon.

As part of the application process you will also be invited to a short parent/teacher consultation with Mr Addis/Mr Baird and myself (Monday 5 – Thursday 9 February). The teachers will update you on your child's progress in class (as they would do every February in parent/teacher consultations) and I will be there to support and advise you regarding the application process.
