Reports – Reports will be sent out via Seesaw on the afternoon of Friday 26 June. Reports are mainly reflective of the work that children completed prior to school closing on Friday 20 March but they may also make reference to some of the activities that the children have completed on Seesaw. I'm sure you can appreciate that it has been very difficult for the teachers to write the reports this year given that they haven't had the children in class from March. End of Key Stage levels for Y4 & Y7 haven't been recorded and nor have PTE/PTM assessment scores as they weren't completed before school closed. It would be my intention that children will complete PTE/PTM assessments at some point in September.

#### **Collecting Books & Personal Belongings**

- Collect children's books and personal belongings on Tuesday 23, Wednesday 24 & Thursday 25 June.
- Nursery parents can collect any items in the front foyer of the main school NOT in the nursery!
- Y1 parents will collect their children's books & belongings just outside Mrs Kidd's room.
- Y2 parents can collect their children's books and belongings by going in the Y1 door and going up the steps to the play area beside the sinks.

- Don't forget about their PE bags, coats etc.
- GIVEN THE CURRENT SITUATION DON'T GO INTO ANY CLASSROOMS!
- ANY ITEMS NOT COLLECTED BY THURSDAY 25 JUNE WILL BE DISPOSED OF!

Y7 Leavers — On Friday 26 June Y7 leavers will be invited to school to collect their hoodies (if they ordered one), their Records of Achievement, their books and any other personal belongings. We are also going to arrange for a photographer to be there in order to take some socially distanced photographs of the boys and girls. It's not the way that we normally send our Y7s off but we thought that this would be a good opportunity to say a bit of a good-bye!! We would love as many of our Y7s to come along as possible. One parent per child is also welcome to come along if they wish. CHILDREN ALSO LEFT LOTS OF PE BAGS, COATS ETC IN THE CLOAKROOMS. THESE ITEMS WILL ALSO BE SET OUT ON A TABLE FOR YOU TO IDENTIFY AND HOPEFULLY TAKE HOME. ANY BOOKS OR PERSONAL ITEMS NOT COLLECTED ON FRIDAY 26 JUNE WILL BE DISPOSED OF!

Returning School Books — We are aware that lots of children will have reading books, library books, mental maths books etc that belong to school. IT IS ABSOLUTELY VITAL THAT THESE BOOKS ARE RETURNED AS WE CANNOT AFFORD TO REPLACE THEM. I WOULD REALLY APPRECIATE YOUR SUPPORT IN THIS MATTER. Please have a rummage in your child's school bag & bedroom and return any books as you collect your child's belongings. There will be boxes/tubs for you to leave any books that belong to school.

Website – The website is live from today and I would encourage you to access the website in order to download the App which we will use for communication. Please see the information sheet below. The App will enable you to receive notifications when information (newsletters etc) is posted on the website and will take you directly to it. It will be very important for you to download the app as all communication over the summer will come through it (SEESAW WILL NOT BE USED)! In the future all newsletters and notes etc will come through the App as we continue to strive towards paperless communication.

**School Uniforms** – Even if children only return to school on a part time basis in September they will all be expected to wear school uniform. The uniform suppliers are Cuddys, Gary's, Gordons and Squarewear.

**Summer School** – Peter Weir has announced that schools can open from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> – Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July for a Summer School for Y5, 6 & 7 children. You won't need to sign up to the system as this is done automatically through school as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details. To install the app, open **www.whiteheadps.com** on your phone or tablet and click the 'Download App' button that appears at the top of the screen.




