#### **PHA Advice**

In line with PHA & DE advice, if anyone in your household is symptomatic AND has arranged a COVID-19 test then your whole household is required to isolate until you have received the results of the test. THEREFORE, YOUR CHILD SHOULD NOT COME INTO SCHOOL UNTIL THE TEST RESULT IS KNOWN.

#### **FLU Vaccinations**

Flu Vaccinations will take place in school on Thursday 15 and Friday 16 October. Your child will have received a flu vaccination form today. The form should be completed, signed and returned by Wednesday 23 September. The form should be returned directly to your child's class teacher who will have a quarantine box in which your child can place the form. CHILDREN CANNOT RECEIVE THEIR FLU VACCINATION unless their form has been returned.

#### **COVID-19 Records**

In order to ensure that COVID-19 records are carefully and accurately maintained please ensure that you inform us if your child is having a Covid test and also what the result of the test is, negative or positive. These confidential records are maintained by Mrs Lowry who informs myself and the child's class teacher.

- In the event of a POSITIVE TEST RESULT outside of school hours please inform Mr Loughins immediately on the new school mobile number 07591559076. Please leave a message if the call isn't picked up. IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT THAT ALL PARENTS USE THIS MOBILE NUMBER IN THE EVENT THAT THEIR CHILD HAS A POSITIVE TEST RESULT OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL HOURS. PLEASE DO NOT USE IT FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE.
